A SERVICE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE

The One Stop Shop is a service for young people aged between 15 and 20, or up to 24 with Special Educational Needs. We offer an inclusive service from one location where young people can access help and support for a wide range of issues.

EDUCATION, TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT

Young people can access support around getting into education, training or employment, job search and CV-building.

Also we can offer opportunities for personal and social development.

HEALTHY LIVING AND RELATIONSHIPS

You can access sessions and advice around topics such as sexual health including Chlamydia screening and condom distribution.

Advice around living a healthy and happy life as well as information and advice on healthy relationships.

Referrals into support services such as SMART (substance intervention.)

MONEY ADVICE AND HOUSING SUPPORT

Come and get advice on benefits, student finance and money issues including referral for local food banks and signposting for funding support.

We also offer some housing advice and a first point of contact if you are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless.

We also work closely with Training Providers, Colleges, Job Centre Plus, Brook Sexual Health and many more to offer as wide a range of support as possible.
